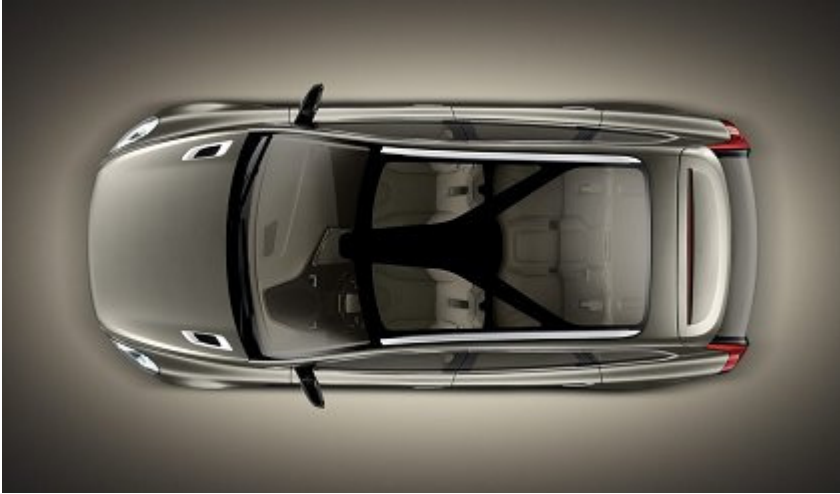


*2007 Volvo XC60*



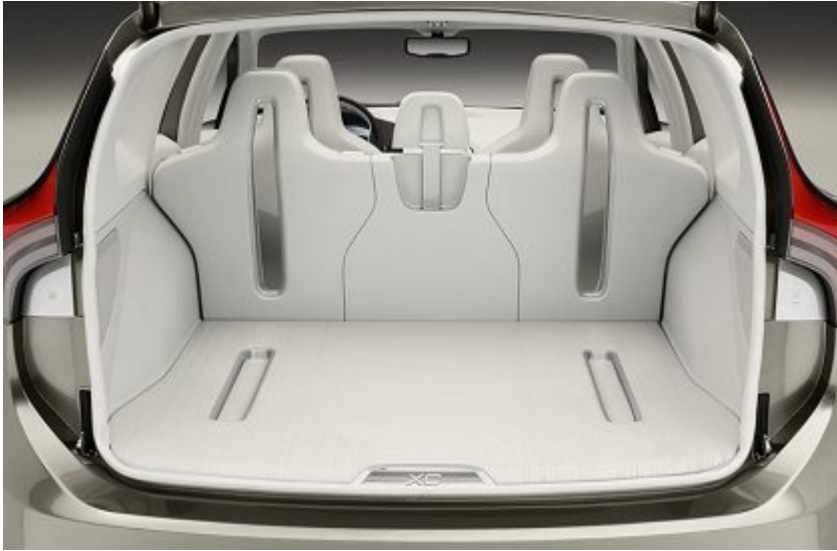












Wonderful birds eye view shows the roof on the Volvo XC60 concept car with its custom Y-shaped structure and transparent, dark-tinted glass roof panels. Exterior styling is a glimpse at the next generation Volvo XC model, which is expected to debut in early 2009. With imposing 20-inch wheels, accentuated wheel housings, and aluminum scuff-plates, the muscular XC60 is painted in a dashing Tin Bronze color. The contours of the tall taillights accentuate the vehicle's muscular shoulders, and the tailgate's trapezoidal shape is a further development of the glass tailgate. Powering the all-wheel drive show car is a 6-cylinder, 3.2-liter bio ethanol engine with 265 horses. Test results indicate that the XC60 accelerates from 0-60 mph in 8.2 seconds and has a top speed of 143 miles per hour. New technology called "City Safety" senses when a low-speed collision is likely to occur, and will pre-charge the brakes to assist the driver in avoiding an accident. Daring interior on the XC60 features slim, visually floating front and rear seats.
